#### **MAINTENANCE TIPS**

#### **Grilling Safety Tips for Summer Barbecues:**

Whether you're a seasoned grill master or just getting started, these essential tips will help keep your cookouts safe, fun, and flame-free!

- Grill Outdoors and Away from Structures: To prevent fire hazards, always grill outside, away
  from buildings, balconies, and overhanging branches.
- Stabilize Your Grill: Set up flat to prevent tipping. Use a grill mat to protect your deck.
- **Keep It Clean:** Regularly remove grease buildup from the grill and tray. Cool charcoal completely before disposing of it in a metal container.
- **Check for Propane Leaks:** Before your first barbecue, test the gas hose with soapy water. Bubbles indicate a leak. Watch for gas smells or issues with lighting the flame.
- Re-light Safely: If the flame goes out, turn off the gas and wait a few minutes before re-lighting.
- Stay Vigilant: Never leave a lit grill unattended. Keep kids and pets away, and remember grills stay hot for at least an hour after use.
- Use Starter Fluid Properly: Use starter fluid only on unlit charcoal grills; never add it to a lit fire.
- **Dress Smart:** Wear sturdy shoes and avoid loose clothing to prevent fire hazards and protect against hot grease or coals.
- Be Fire-Ready: Always keep baking soda and a fire extinguisher nearby for grease fires. Never
  use water on a grease fire.
