MAINTENANCE TIPS

Snake Safety

Snakes will avoid people if they can. If they feel threatened and cannot find a way to escape, **THEY WILL DEFEND THEMSELVES BY STRIKING!**

If you see a snake:

- Stay calm and keep an eye on it from a safe distance.
- DO NOT try to catch it, DO NOT try to kill it, DO NOT make it feel threatened by throwing things at it or poking it with a stick.
- Report it by calling (830) 298-4145 and warn others to stay away from it until Entomology is dispatched.
- If you see a snake in a building, leave the room and close the door to contain it until help arrives.
